Tips and Tidbits

GENERAL:

- In Arizona, 90% of the Indians are 100% Indian with no intermarriage; in California, it is the opposite
- In Arizona 15% of the land is private property; 85% is government property
- The Apache reservation on the east side of 4 Peaks; nomadic
- The Maricopa Indians lived on the River with the Pima
- The Indian people are concerned with "where" events happen; Anglos are concerned with "when" events happen
- The concept of "ownership" was behind most Indian wars - everything they had was for "sharing"; only whites believed in "owning"
- PAI means "people"
 - Yavapai - people from the east (Prescott, Sedona, Montezuma's Castle)
 - Hualapai - people of the big trees
 - Havasupai - people of the blue water (bottom of the Grand Canyon)

Northeast	Colorado Plateau	17" rain
Central	Mogollon Rim	37" rain
	(there are 10 lakes here - the Yavapai moved from this area)	
Southwest	Sonoran Desert	6-1/2" rain

One-half of the rain falls between January and February - female rain
(comes from California)

One-half of the rain falls between July and September - male rain
